

Below is a record from our minutes on ODCA meeting on October 4, 2006

A preliminary vote was held to determine whether ODCA (1) generally supports the project with a list of issues; (2) needs more time to study the project and wants to defer the vote; or (3) does not support the project. The preliminary vote tally was 23 generally support; 2 defer, and 2 do not support.

ODCA members then drafted the list of issues/questions to go with the resolution of support:

- Need construction management plan (parking for workers, etc.).
- Need a liaison with the community during construction.
- Need a traffic study of impact on Glebe/Lee intersection.
- Need monitoring of student and faculty parking on neighborhood streets.
- Need to address pedestrian traffic from the Library to the new facility, particularly for the Yorktown Blvd./26th Street intersection.

A final vote was held on the resolution with the above list. The final vote tally was 24 in favor; 3 opposed.
