

Welcome to Arlington's Rosslyn-Ballston Corridor

The Rosslyn-Ballston (R-B) corridor is one of the region's hottest new areas. It is actually a series of five distinctive "urban villages" developed around Metro stations where you can live, work, shop, and play within a delightfully walkable, pedestrian-friendly environment. If you drive here, this guide can help you find public parking near your destination in each of these "villages."

This guide shows many transportation services including:

- **On-Street Parking:** Over 1,500 economical short-term and long-term spaces.
- **Public Garages:** Color-coded to show when they are open.
- **ART 66 and 67 Free Lunch Loop Shuttles:** Operate on a continuous loop weekdays from 11:00 am – 2:00 pm.
- **Carshare Parking Spaces:** Rent a car for as short a time as 30 minutes.

ParkSmart CARDS

The ParkSmart card is a prepaid debit card. It can be used to pay for metered parking at silver, blue, red and green meters designated with a ParkSmart sticker. You can purchase the card online at CommuterDirect.com, or in person at the Arlington County Treasurer's Office, 2100 Clarendon Boulevard, Suite 215, and at Arlington County Commuter Stores in Crystal City, Rosslyn and Ballston.

Alternate Ways of Getting Around Arlington

ART—Arlington Transit supplements Metrobus with smaller, neighborhood-friendly vehicles that provide access to Metrorail and Virginia Railway Express (VRE). Most of ART's buses operate on clean-burning natural gas and offer dependable schedules to keep you on time. There are two free lunchtime shuttle buses to make it even easier to get around the corridor.

- ART 53 – Ballston Metro - Old Glebe - East Falls Church Metro

- ART 66 – FREE Clarendon - Court House Lunch Loop Shuttle
- ART 67 – FREE Ballston - Virginia Square Lunch Loop Shuttle

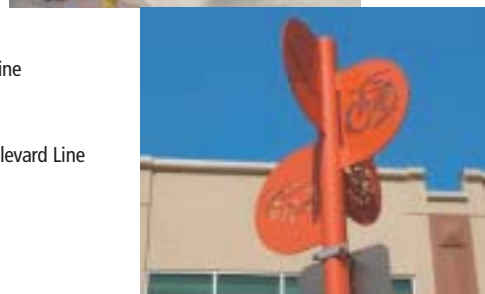
METROBUS is the Washington, DC metropolitan area's regional bus system with 18 major bus lines and approximately 99 individual route variations serving Arlington.



Metrobus routes serving the Rosslyn-Ballston Corridor include:

- 1 B, C, D, E, F, Z – Wilson Boulevard - Fairfax Line
- 2 A, B, C, G – Washington Boulevard Line
- 3 A, B, E – Lee Highway Line
- 4 A, B, E, H, S – Pershing Drive - Arlington Boulevard Line
- 5 A – DC - Dulles Line
- 5 B – DC - Tysons Corner Line
- 10 B – Hunting Towers - Ballston Line
- 15 K, L – Chain Bridge Road Line
- 22 A – Barcroft - South Fairlington Line
- 23 A, C – McLean - Crystal City Line
- 24 P – Ballston - Pentagon Line
- 25 A, F, G, J, P, R – Ballston - Bradley - Pentagon Line
- 25 B – Landmark - Ballston Line
- 38 B – Ballston - Farragut Square Line – "The Orange Line with a View"

METRO RAIL serves 83 stations throughout the area along 103 miles of track. The Metrorail system is comprised of five color-coded lines—Blue, Green, Orange, Yellow, and Red—that intersect at various points, making it possible to change trains and travel anywhere on the system. Metrorail's Orange line, with stops at Rosslyn, Court House, Clarendon, Virginia Square, and Ballston, serves the R-B corridor. The Blue line also stops in Rosslyn. CARSHARING is the solution for those times when you need a car. It's a lot like car rental, but more convenient. With carsharing, you can rent the car for as little as an half-hour. Cars are self-service. The price includes gas, insurance, and maintenance and you only pay for the time you use. Arlington County has partnered with **Flexcar** and **Zipcar** to create a pilot program in the R-B corridor. The county has designated 20 easy-to-find, on-street parking spaces for carsharing vehicles. All are convenient to Metrorail, Metrobus and ART bus service and are marked with bright orange signposts. WALKING AND BIKING to and within the R-B corridor is a fast and easy way to get around. Arlington's extensive bikeway system includes trails and bike lanes that connect to just about anywhere you want to travel. Bicycle parking is available at all Metro stations and at key locations along commercial streets. It is often quicker and easier to walk or ride a bike than to drive, and it is definitely healthier and more fun.
