## Addition to Prescription Medication Program (PMP)

### Will Arlington program lower medication costs for me?



(1) [Prescription Medication Program \(PMP\)](#) offers access to **discounted medications** to residents of Arlington County who are income eligible\* elders (55+), and persons permanently and totally disabled according to the standard set by Social Security and/or Veteran's Administration.

(2) Pharmacy Connection adds access to **free medications** to the same populations as identified above.

### How do I get connected to PMP and Pharmacy Connection?

Initial application is made to [Prescription Medication Program \(PMP\)](#).



To obtain a form, call (703) 228-1350 or TTY (703) 228-1398.

Acceptance places you on PMP's Wait List. Pharmacy Connection staff contact you to determine whether options match your needs.

### What information is needed from you?

Identify physicians' name and your current prescription needs, when you speak with the Medication Advocates from the Pharmacy Connection.



### How will my medication costs be reduced?

You **MAY** receive free medications from any company that offers a patient assistance program that matches your medication needs.
