

# **DRAFT TAC Charter Changes**

# Goals

- Uniformity with the Ped Advisory Committee (PAC) and Bicycle Advisory Committee (BAC) Charters
  - Format and general language on meetings/duration/appointments
- Attempt to increase diversity
- Annual multimodal meeting among the TAC, PAC, and BAC

# Major Changes

- Adding a Vision Statement which ties to the County's overall Vision
  - Would be the same/similar Vision Statement as the PAC and BAC
- Removal of the requirement to have a member of a County Commission as part of the TAC (Transportation, Disability, & Aging)
  - Try to increase more diversity within Committees (individuals on Commissions are still able to participate; however, there would not be a requirement)
- A joint annual multimodal meeting with the TAC, PAC, and BAC
  - This would be during either a regularly scheduled meeting of the TAC, PAC, or BAC or a separate special meeting
- Modifications to the Accessibility Subcommittee language
  - Minimum and max membership and how such individuals are appointed

- Final adoption TBD (will be based on feedback received between all three Committees and County Manager's acceptance)
