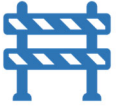


Shared Street Pilot Project

What is a Pilot Project?



Pilot projects allow staff to study the effectiveness of new tools or techniques to manage or adjust how the roadway is used. Pilot Projects use temporary materials so they can be adjusted or removed easily.

Why?



The Neighborhood Complete Streets program is trialing two new tools, a shared street sign and shared street stamp to improve driver behavior, and the comfort of bicyclists and pedestrians all sharing the same space.

Because of existing constraints, a sidewalk cannot be provided at this time.

How long is this pilot?



The pilot project will be observed for one year.
