Phase Two Project Goals

Guided by the complete streets policy in the Master Transportation Plan, this project aims to:

- Provide **better connectivity** for people walking and biking by improving bike facilities and pedestrian crossings through tactical improvements
- **Reduce complexity** at 9th Street S by realigning the intersection
- **Allow controlled access** to and from 9th Street S by signaling the intersection

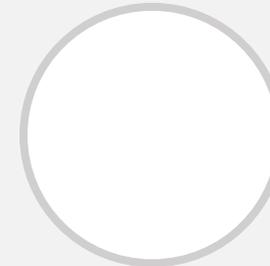

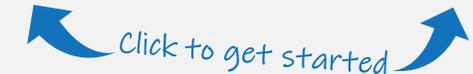
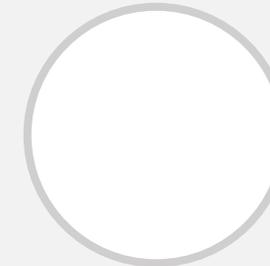
