ORDER REGARDING FACE COVERING IN THE COURTHOUSE

THIS MATTER came before the Court *sua sponte* in response to revised guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) regarding the wearing of face coverings in communities with low COVID-19 levels;

IT APPEARING that the current COVID-19 Community Level for Arlington County is “Low”;

IT FURTHER APPEARING that the wearing of face coverings in communities with low COVID-19 levels is no longer recommended by the CDC;


ORDERED that effective March 3, 2022, until further order of this Court, this Court’s order of May 14, 2020 is rescinded; and it is further,

ORDERED that effective March 3, 2022 persons who enter the Arlington County Courthouse are not required to wear a face mask covering his/her nose and mouth; and it is further,

ORDERED that persons entering the courthouse who wish to wear a face mask are permitted to do so provided the mask is without any markings facing outward other an identifying mark pre-applied by the manufacture of a manufactured face mask; and further,

IT IS SO ORDERED.
