


# How to Recognize an OPIOID OVERDOSE




Slow or shallow breathing




Cold or clammy skin  
Blue or gray skin



Dizziness or confusion



Vomiting or gurgling



**Not responsive or sleeping and cannot be woken**

**Deep gurgling or rattling snore**



Blue/gray lips  
and/or fingernails

## WHAT TO DO?

1. Call 911
2. Administer Naloxone
3. Rescue Breathing

*Naloxone (NARCAN) is a safe and effective medication that reverses the effects of opioid overdose. **If there is any doubt, administer naloxone.** Naloxone only works on opioids but will not cause any harm if administered when unnecessary.*
