“Interconnected Roots” by Edgar Reyes
June and July, 2022

Artist Edgar Reyes leads participants in the creation of a temporary community mural exploring the nature of “native”—referencing both plant, bird and insect species, but also about his journey as an American with Indigenous and European roots. In the fall, the panels will be united into one large temporary mural at Kenmore Middle School. Representatives from Arlington County’s Urban Forestry and Natural Resources Management Office along with Plant Nova Natives will offer on growing native plants and tree care. Free native plant seeds will be offered until supplies last.
