Shirley Memorial Hwy), and also U.S. 1 (Richmond Hwy), U.S. 29 (Langston Blvd), U.S. 50 (Arlington Blvd), State Route 123 (Chain Bridge Rd), State Route 309 (Old Dominion Dr), State Route 124 (Spout Run Pkwy from Langston Blvd to Lorcom Ln), State Route 233 (Airport Viaduct) and also the segment of Washington Blvd (Route 237) from N Glebe Rd to Langston Blvd.
