Welcome and Attendance

The Community Oversight Board (COB) was called to order by COB Chair Evans at 6:34 p.m. Attendance was taken by voice.

Prior Meeting Minutes

At 6:33 p.m. Chair Evans introduced IPA Mummi Ibrahim to provide an update on investigations and discuss the investigation protocol document.
