Overview

- Drone survey conducted March 2025
- Covered almost all of Arlington (except certain federal lands & urban high-rise zones)




Core Takeaways

- The observed deer population has decreased since the 2021 drone survey
- The observed deer population is still 3x to 6x recommended levels in key wildlife corridors
- Ongoing management is still indicated to support forest health and protect biodiversity




Management By Wildlife Corridor

- DPR will focus management within the Potomac & Four Mile Run Corridors
- Deer don't recognize park boundaries they move across natural areas and neighborhoods
- Holistic approach better reflects actual deer behavior
- Field operations will occur on only DPR and select NOVA parks properties, but population density will be measured at the corridor level



Summer


- Procure professional sharpshooting contractor

 Establish and begin annual monitoring of randomized browse survey plots


Jan-Feb 2026:

 Conduct professional sharpshooting if indicated by data




Browse Survey and Exclosure Locations

Browse Survey and Exclosure Locations

- Randomized browse survey plots will be established within the natural lands symbolized in green
- One exclosure will be established within each blue park
- Both will be monitored annually
