  - The Green Infrastructure Center's Karen Firehock, provided a presentation of the Center's Study of Arlington's Tree Canopy. Using both LIDAR and Imaging data set analyses show Arlington with 33% tree canopy cover. This is a loss of 8% since 2016. (Study excluded the airport and DoD properties.   - Vincent Verweij Urban Forest Manager, discussed Dead and Downed Tree policy
    of the County. Unless trees provide a danger of falling on nearby trails, dead
    trees are cut down to a height of 15 feet and left standing to create vertical
    habitat. Arlington has updated its master of recommended trees for a variety of
    light, moisture and other conditions.

Major points: "The FNRC strongly recommends making permanent the one-time increases in FY 2024 for tree maintenance and for invasive species control, adding funding to restore full Nature Center hours, creating a specific program to increase the biodiversity and ecological value of our crucial parks and natural spaces, and living up to the County's commitment to acquire new land for parks."
