

## PROCLAMATION

## **LGBTQIA+ PRIDE MONTH**

**WHEREAS,** June is recognized globally as Pride Month, a time to celebrate the diversity, resilience, and contributions of the LGBTQIA+ community; and

WHEREAS, Arlington County takes pride in its diverse and inclusive community, which includes individuals of all sexual orientations, gender identities, and gender expressions; and

WHEREAS, June commemorates the anniversary of the Stonewall Uprising of June 1969, a pivotal moment in the movement for LGBTQIA+ equality when patrons of the Stonewall Inn in New York City stood up against police harassment and discrimination; and

WHEREAS, Arlington County has a strong history of supporting LGBTQIA+ rights, including adding "sexual orientation" to the group of classes protected under its antidiscrimination policy in 1992, and being the first jurisdiction in Virginia to extend domestic partner benefits to County employees in 1997; and

**WHEREAS**, despite significant progress, the LGBTQIA+ community continues to face threats, including rising violence, discriminatory legislation, and social stigmatization; and

WHEREAS, in 2024-2025, our nation has experienced unprecedented challenges to LGBTQIA+ rights, with more than 500 bills introduced in state legislatures targeting transgender healthcare, limiting LGBTQIA+ content in schools, and restricting gender-affirming care, making local protections and affirmations more crucial than ever; and

WHEREAS, Arlington remains committed to fostering a community where LGBTQIA+ individuals can live authentically without fear of prejudice or discrimination, and where diversity is celebrated as a strength and community value that enriches our civic life;

**NOW THEREFORE,** the County Board of Arlington, Virginia, does hereby proclaim **June**, as **LGBTQIA+ PRIDE MONTH** in Arlington County and encourage all residents to join in celebrating the rich diversity, history, and contributions of the LGBTQIA+ community.
