

Background

- 3108 Columbia Pike was acquired by the County in March 2022
- Interim Use: Serve as APS overflow parking during Career Center redevelopment
- Future Use: Potential site for the relocated Columbia Pike Library and County Board priorities such as affordable housing; community engagement process for the long-term vision to be determined

Existing Site


- 3-story building, not compatible for public use
- 63 parking spaces


Project Goals

- Restore site to grade level
- Expand parking to approximately 92 spaces

Expand parking


Lease to APS

(Spring 2024)

Lease parking lot to APS for overflow parking for Career Center staff and contractors

What to Expect for Demolition

- Contractor to provide more information before the start of work, including:
 - Vacate parking lot
 - Schedule and work hours follow noise ordinance
 - Site safety and security plan around the site
- Demolition activities:
 - Tree protection and fencing
 - Construction safety and security fencing
 - Sediment and erosion control features
 - Selective deconstruction and removal
 - Site grading and landscaping
 - Paving
