## Arlington County Treasurer's Office Recognized for Achieving Accreditation

The Arlington County Treasurer's Office received its annual accreditation from the Treasurers' Association of Virginia (TAV) on June 24, 2025. The Office Accreditation program is a voluntary professional certificate program overseen by TAV. This office has achieved accreditation for more than 10 years.

This year, 73 other offices from across the Commonwealth joined the Arlington County Treasurer's Office in receiving accreditation. While it is not required for any treasurer's office to be accredited, accreditation acknowledges that the office meets the statewide best practices for performance in treasury management.

As part of the accreditation process, offices must successfully pass an outside audit with no findings of material weakness. The rigorous accreditation process also requires proof of continuing education, such as completion of an ethics course by the treasurer (or a principal officer) and educational requirements for all staff. Accredited offices are required to have written policies in place addressing areas such as personnel, customer service, and delinquent collections.

"We are honored to recognize the commitment and hard work of the 74 offices that have attained accreditation this year, as they exemplify the quality and professionalism that we strive for in our field."
