

# Lorcom Lane Safety Project

Lorcom Lane from N Quebec Street to Nelly Custis Drive

**Project Background.** The Lorcom Lane safety project will deliver multimodal safety improvements on Lorcom Lane from 24th Rd North/North Quebec Street to Nelly Custis Drive. This project originated through crash data, community-reported transportation safety concerns and results of the Vision Zero Pilot Safety Project.

Since March 2021, temporary parking restrictions provide a walking path on the north side of Lorcom Lane between N Quebec Street and N Oakland Street as part of a Vision Zero Pilot Project. In addition to constructing a permanent sidewalk in that section, the overall project vision includes:

- upgrading existing sidewalks and ramps to meet current Americans with Disabilities Act standards
- resolve alignment issues at N. Quebec Street and Lorcom Lane
- address safety issues at Nelly Custis Drive and Lorcom Lane
