

Project Area



- Fairfax Drive and Kirkwood Road
 - Kirkwood Rd from Washington Blvd to Fairfax Dr
 - N Jackson Street from Fairfax Dr to Wilson Blvd
- In 2018, Arlington acquired jurisdiction of the VA-237 corridor from the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT).

Goals & Planning Guidance

- The intersection project seeks to improve safety for people walking and rolling, taking transit, biking, and driving.
- The **Master Transportation Plan Bicycle Element** (2019) identifies Fairfax Drive as a primary bicycle corridor.
- The Clarendon Sector Plan (2022) identifies the project intersection as an improvement area to better connect the western end of Clarendon to the central Clarendon.
- Vision Zero High-Injury Network Audit (January 2023) also identifies this intersection as a capital project to improve safety in the corridor.
- The project is in the Arlington Public Schools (APS) Walk Zone for Washington and Liberty High School.



Bicycle/Scooter Concerns	 Concern over ability of cargo bikes maneuverability Interest in adding a bike box in EB Fairfax Drive left turn lane Desire for vertical protection for eastbound bike lane on Fairfax Drive Desire for bike path from SB Kirkwood Road to EB Fairfax Drive median to facilitate left turn movement Project Team will review specific bike movements when overall design for bike
	routes is confirmed.
Motor Vehicle Concerns	 Desire to extend median on Fairfax Drive to serve as barrier to prevent vehicles from heading toward Jackson Street
	Project Team will review when overall intersection geometric layout is confirmed.



Final Concept - Fairfax Dr/Kirkwood Rd


Added vertical protection on Kirkwood Road.

Removed flipped directional bike crossing.

Added two-way bike skip marks adjacent to high visibility crosswalk.

Added bike protection island with mountable curb, closing Jackson Street for motor vehicles while allowing bike/scooter access through Jackson Street.

*Project team continues to review the effectiveness of bike protection island at this location given recent feedback on safety and fire truck access.



Separated bikes from pedestrians in the large median island, making wayfinding easier.


- Pedestrian spaces are separated by raised header curb from bike lanes.
- WB Fairfax Drive continues through the island, crosses over Kirkwood Rd and through a protected intersection corner.
- SB Kirkwood Rd to EB Fairfax Drive are facilitated through the large median island.
- EB Fairfax Drive to NB
 Kirkwood Rd movement is
 provided through separated
 bike lanes.

Trimmed median nose to reduce potential conflict with vehicles from EB left turn pocket on Fairfax Dr continuing east on Fairfax Drive through the intersection.


Final Concept – Washington Blvd/Kirkwood Rd

Added bike skip marks in NB and SB direction through Washington Blvd/Kirkwood Rd intersection


Added vertical protection on Kirkwood Road.
