WHAT IS THE
DIT COUNT:HUD mandates each Continuum of Care (CoC)
to count how many people are experiencing
homelessness on one given night in January.
This includes those residing in shelter and
those sleeping outdoors.WHY TARGET
THE YOUTH:In addition to the traditional PIT Count,
Arlington's CoC hosted a Youth & Young Adult
PIT Count. Teens and young people have
different needs and may not always engage in
traditional forms of homeless outreach and
services.

WHAT IS A TAY? Transitional-aged youth (TAY) is defined as a young person between the ages of 16 and 24 years. The term TAY speaks to the unique developmental needs of teens and young adults.

WHAT DID YOUNG PEOPLE HAVE TO SAY?

During the 2025 Youth & Young Adult PIT Count, 73 TAYs were surveyed about the biggest issues facing people their age.
