



DHS Adult Behavioral Health, Community Services Board, and Clarendon House
2120 Washington Boulevard, Arlington, VA 22204 (Sequoia 2)

DHS programs operate out of three buildings on the Sequoia Plaza campus. The majority of programs (with the notable exception of adult mental health and substance use programs) are in the 2100 Washington Blvd. building. The 2120 building is home to programs for DHS's adult behavioral healthcare programs. This building is adjacent to the parking garage but access requires exiting the garage and using the main building entrance.

By METRO or ART Bus

- ART: Routes 42, 45 and 77 serve the Human Services Center at Sequoia Plaza area.
- METROBUS: Routes 16 (H, K, P, Y) and 4 (A, H) are among the Metro bus routes that serve the Human Services Center at Sequoia Plaza area.

By Car

Driving directions from I-395 and I-66

- From I-395: Exit at Route 27 (Washington Boulevard). Merge onto Washington Boulevard. Proceed north approximately 0.2 mile. Exit onto 2nd St S. Turn right at S Court House Rd. and take gentle left at intersection. Human Services Center is on the right opposite the traffic circle.
- From I-66 Heading East: Take exit 72 for US-29/Lee Hwy toward Spout Run Pkwy. Turn right at Lee Hwy/US-29 N. Turn right at N Kirkwood Rd. Turn left at N Washington Blvd. Take the 1st right to stay on N Washington Blvd. Turn right at S Court House Rd. and stay to the right. Human Services Center is on the right opposite the traffic circle.

Driving directions from Glebe Road

- From South Arlington: Turn right on Columbia Pike. Turn left on Court House Rd. Proceed straight past 2nd St. and then take gentle left at intersection. Human Services Center is on the right opposite the traffic circle.
- From North Arlington: Turn right onto the US-50 E ramp. Exit onto S Washington Blvd. toward Pentagon/I-395. Take immediate right at S Court House Rd. Human Services Center is on the right opposite the traffic circle.

Parking

Free garage parking (**blue level**) is available for DHS visitors while at Sequoia Plaza. If the garage is filled, use street parking.

- There are 23 accessible garage parking spaces. They are located in the B1, lobby and 2nd floor levels.
- There are 2 accessible exterior parking spaces: one outside of the garage in front of the clock tower elevator lobby and one in front of Sequoia 3 (adult Behavioral Healthcare building at 2120 Washington Blvd.).
